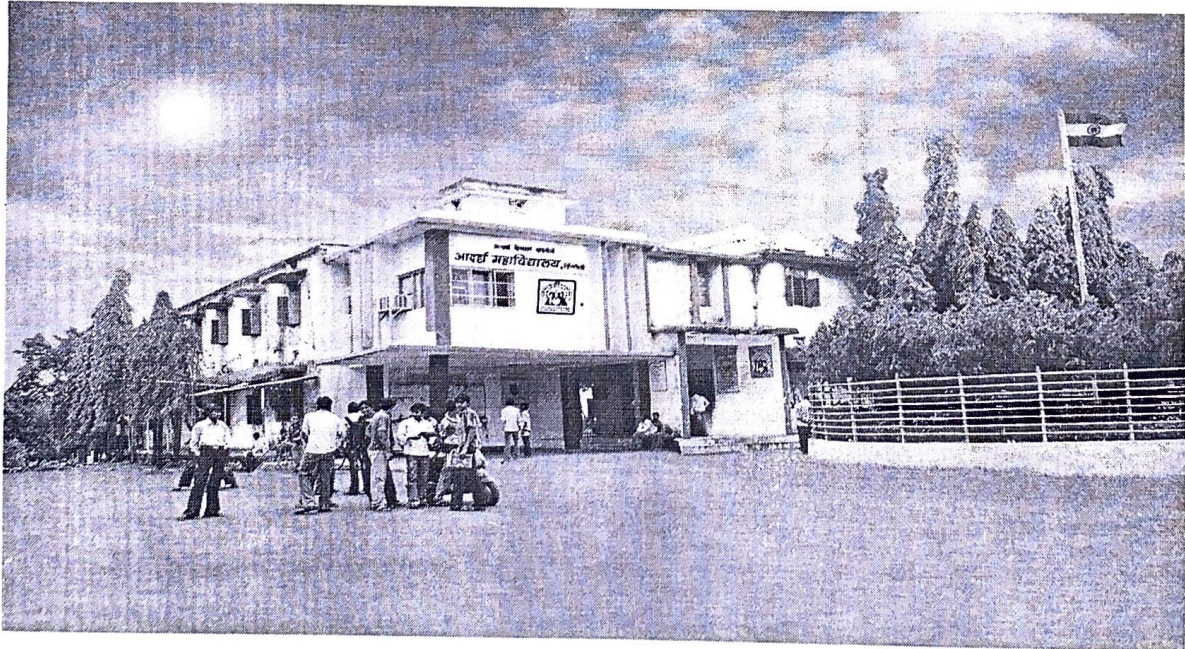

The Environment and Energy usage policy of the College, implies to explore the renewable energy resources to reduce the burden of the government and to find out substitute natural resources as solutions to the energy crisis.

This environment and energy policy is binding for all the components of the institution and applies to all its participants and to the various activities undertaken by the institution. It will help us to implement efficiency and environmental awareness to conservation of natural resources and to limit its usage.

Policies:

- To establish Green Audit, Environment Audit and Energy Audit Committee.
- To generate mass awareness of cleanliness and hygiene among the students and staff.
- To move towards Plastic Free Campus.
- To initiate No Vehicle day.
- To assess our energy usage and measure its impact on the environment.
- To install solar panels for the generation of alternate energy.
- Turn off your monitor when you leave your table. Whenever possible, shut down rather than logging off.
- Turn off unnecessary lights and use daylight instead.
- Use LED or compact fluorescent bulbs as much as possible.
- Switch off lights, fans in conference rooms, classrooms, lecture halls when they are not in use.
- Use the fans only when they are needed.
- In hostels install the water heaters with non-conventional energy resources.

- To reduce local air pollution emission using bicycles, public transportation and use of pedestrian – friendly roads.
- To undertake tree plantation drive.
- To establish Students Clubs regarding Nature Conservation.
- To organise programmes through NSS and NCC.
- To encourage use of advanced technology to minimize energy consumption, atmospheric emission and noise.
- To monitor and respond to emerging environmental and energy issues. To strengthen our employees' and students' environmental knowledge and skills in order to improve our own environmental performance.
- To provide information and training opportunities on energy saving measures.
